# FINANCIAL REPORT OF WORLD'S SKATING MEET SHOWS SURPLUS

## MONEY USED TO REDUCE SKATING ASSOC. DEFICIT

Heaviest Expense Item Was Cost of Grandstand Construction

A surplus of \$688.80 was realized at the world's skating meet held here during the winter, according to the financial report just completed and issued yesterday by A. P. Peterson.

The delay in completing the statement was occasioned by the fact that the financial committee was compelled to await the report from the circuit regarding various expenses, and it was only recently that T. Simpson, chairman of the finance committee, and A. L. Foster, treasurer, was able to present the statement to the executive.

The report of the Saint John Skating Association was also given out at the same time, and this showed that there was still a deficit of \$886.96 from the previous year although this year's surplus from the meet had been used to reduce the original amount.

Referring to this deficit, a citizen said yesterday that, if the association was to carry on effectively, it would require financial assistance, and he felt it was up to the local sport lovers to wipe out the amount remaining. He pointed out that outside the \$1 membership fee the association had received no financial grants from any person. The membership was very small, he declared, for so great an organization, having only 250 when it should have at least 1,000 members.

The report of the meet showed that the cost of constructing the grandstand was heavy. This erecting of the grandstand at so great a cost each year was unfortunate, several citizens said yesterday when discussing the matter, and they felt that if some arrangement could be made so that it would be possible that a permanent stand could be put up at not too great a cost it would eventually prove great saving. The stand and buildings this year cost \$4,177.10 for construction and removal.

Bringing the total to American skaters was another heavy item of expense although a portion of it was borne by other cities where he appeared.

One of the outstanding features of the meet, a skating enthusiast said yesterday, a special tribute should be paid to D. J. Corr by the citizens for the way he labored unceasingly to put over the meet successfully. With his knowledge of the work, this man declared he was really the spearhead of the organization in its activities.

## MITCHELL KNOCKS OUT JACK REDDICK

### 2,000 Halifax Fans See Championship Claimant Take Count in Third

Halifax, N. S., April 23.—Jack Reddick, Toronto, claimant of the lightweight championship of Canada, was knocked out in the third round of his scheduled 10-round bout with Roy Mitchell, local colored, light-heavyweight, here tonight. The men were announced as both overweight and the title was not at stake.

The fight was staged before some 2,000 fans, many of whom cheered the Toronto boxer throughout the short space of time he faced his colored challenger. The first round was a sparring match with neither man coming up to the expectations of the crowd. Each seemed to be feeling the other out and with the exception of a few half-hearted swings, both were wary. Reddick appeared to be in poor shape for a fight while the negro was evidently in good form.

## MITCHELL WORRIES OPPONENT

In the second, Mitchell opened out and worried the title claimant with right swings to the jaw. They both mixed and Mitchell took a couple of lumps on the head but they were later advertised not to hurt him. Mitchell tried for Reddick's body and the latter complained that he was hitting low.

When the bell rang for the third, Mitchell ploughed in with a volley of left jabs and right swings that defied all the boxing ability of Reddick and he tried to get up. He became groggy and Mitchell pushed him around the ring landing often. Near the end of the round Mitchell landed a light right to the head, followed quickly with a left jab that half turned the Toronto man around, then swung a mighty right that sent Reddick crashing face down on the floor.

## BADLY OUT

There was no need for the referee to count the defeated man out, so far as the spectators were concerned, and they all left their seats amid great uproar. Mitchell danced about in his corner until the last count, then rushed to help the fallen man. Reddick was badly knocked out and it was not until ten minutes later in his dressing room that he was himself again.
