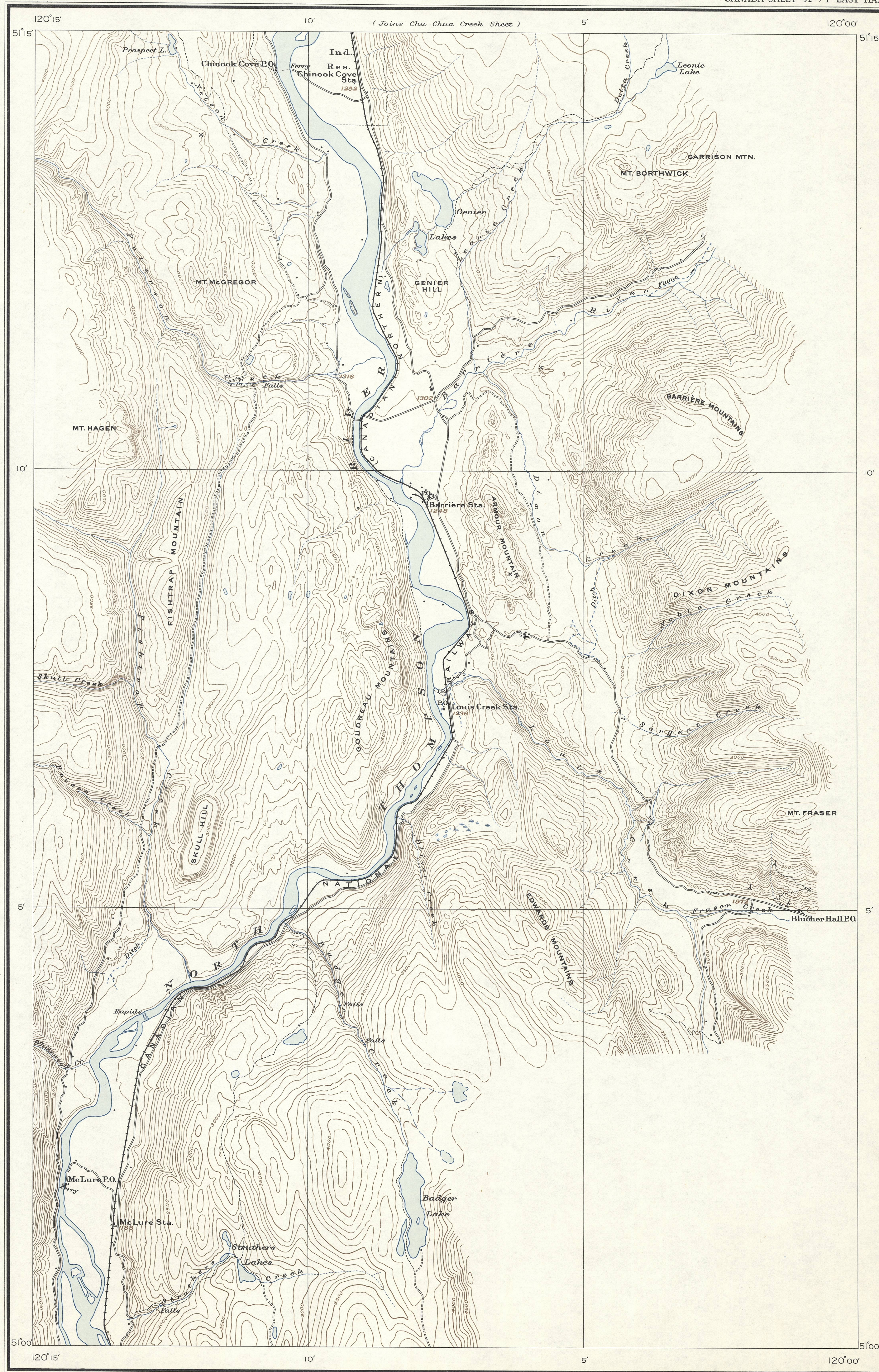

CANADA SHEET 92 P/1 EAST HALF

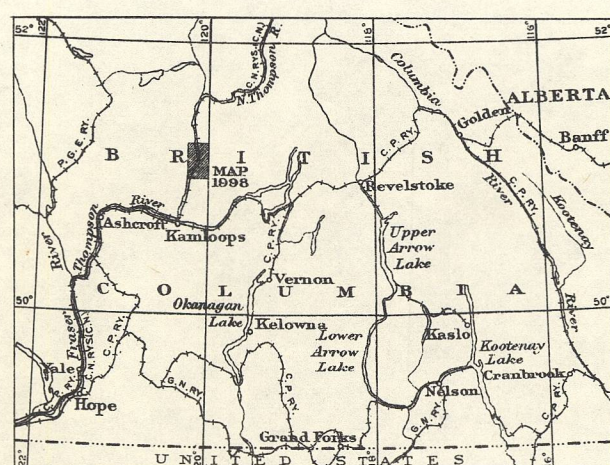

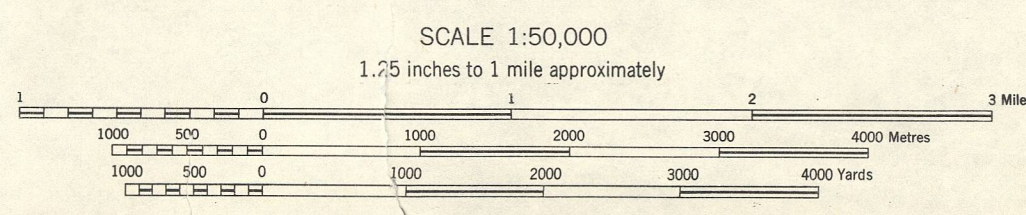
