

THIS INDENTURE made in duplicate this 5th day of  
September, A.D. 1935;

BETWEEN:

SINCLAIR-MORLEY OIL STRUCTURES SYNDICATE  
LIMITED, a company incorporated under the  
laws of the Province of Alberta in that  
behalf, and having its Registered Office  
at the City of Calgary in the Province of  
Alberta, (hereinafter called "the Assignor")

OF THE FIRST PART

- and -

JOHN CHARLES DALLAS, of the City of Calgary  
in the Province of Alberta, Oil Operator,  
(hereinafter called "the Assignee")

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS by an indenture of lease (hereinafter re-  
ferred to as "the said Lease") dated the 27th day of July, A.D. 1926  
and made between His Majesty King George the Fifth represented  
therein by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs of Canada,  
as Lessor, and one H. J. Robie, of the City of Calgary in the  
Province of Alberta, as Lessee, all and singular that certain parcel  
or tract of land situate, lying and being in the Province of Alberta  
containing Two thousand two hundred and ninety-seven (2,297) acres  
more or less, comprised of:

FIRST: A parcel of land bounded as follows: On the north by the  
south shore of the Bow River; on the east by the westerly  
boundary of parcel as shown on plan M 2146 known as Hook  
No. 2; on the south by the northerly limit of the right  
of way of the Canadian Pacific Railway and on the west by  
the easterly limit of the lands as indicated on plan M2142  
containing by admeasurement one thousand and sixty-five  
acres more or less;

SECOND: A parcel of land described as follows: Bounded on the  
north by the southerly limit of the right of way of the  
Canadian Pacific Railway; on the east by the westerly  
limit of parcel known as Hook No. 5 as shown on plan  
M2146; on the south by the northerly boundary of parcel  
as indicated on plan M 2143 and on the west by the
