

RING ANNALS 1824-Tom Spring defeated Jack Lan-gan in 77 rounds at Chichester, England. Spring, whose real name was Thomas Whiter, had succeeded "Ould Tom". Cribb as champion of England, while Lan-gan, a native of County Kildare and an exceldier, had fought his way to the top of the heap in Ireland. Some 40,000 spectators gathered about the ring, which was pitched in an open field, to see the memorable conflict be tween Englishman and Ireland. Thousands of sports had come over from the Emerald Isle and they backed Langan with every-thing they owned, in a vain en-deavor to cover all the Spring money In sight. Hewlings, the local Inn-keeper, was in charge of the arrangements for the battle, having purchased all privileges from the fighters for Sto0 each, and as the first pur-listic promoter he accumulated a fortune from his invest-ment. The battle lasted meany two hours and a half, and the way, but in the end he was vangished by the more exper-enced Englishman. It is said that many Irish families now living in England are the de-scendants of those Irish sports who wagered all they possessed on Langan, and didn't have enough money left to get home. 
