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ANSWERS TO CORRESPONDENTS.—(Con.)

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ALICIA:—An umbrella dealer says: "The right way to roll your umbrella is to take hold of the ends of the ribs and the stick with one hand, and hold the ribs tightly enough to prevent their being twisted while the covering is being twirled round with the other hand. Then your umbrella will be as nicely closed as it was when you bought it, and the only wear and tear will be on the cloth. It is twisting the ribs out of shape round the stick and fastening them thus that spoils most umbrellas."

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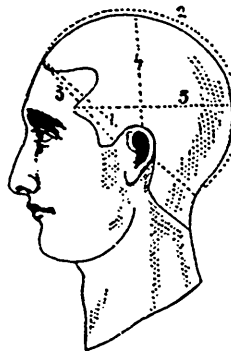
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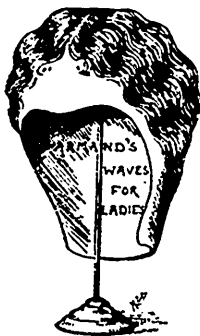
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
