(53) XVL

The Ratifications of the two Kings, and the States General, fhall be all three exchang'd at London at the fame time, within the fpace of three Weeks, reckoning from the day that the States General shall have figned, or sooner, if possible. Done and figned at London, ³/₂₁ Febr. V. S. 1700. by us Plenipotentiaries of France and England; and at the Hagne, the 35th of the states General, the two Kings and the faid States General having agreed that the figning of this present Treaty should be performed in this manner. In witness whereof we have figned the faid present Treaty with our Hands, and caused the Seals of our Arms to be affixed.
