## C A P. XIX.

An Act to continue, until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and ten, an Act made in the Forty-fixth Year of His present Majesty, for permitting the Importation of Masts, Yards, Bowsprits, and Timber, for Naval Purposes, from the British Colonies in North America, Dutyfree. [21st March 1808.]

HEREAS the Law herein-after mentioned has by Experience been found useful and beneficial, and it is expedient that the fame should be continued; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That an Act made in the 46G.3.c.117. Forty-fixth Year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act to continued till March 25, permit until the First Day of January One thousand eight hundred and nine, 1810.
