I beg to inclose form of surrender, in duplicate, of Reserves 9 and 10, on the west side of
Okanagan Lake, B. C., a for the purpose of exchange
for other land, and have to request that you will be
good enough to submit the same to the Indians, as required by the provisions of the Indian Act.

If the surrender is assented to, you should have the
documents dated and signed by a number of the Indians in
your presence, and then an affidavit of execution made
on the forms attached by yourself and a Ghief and
Principal Man or two principal men, before a Judge,
stipendiary Magistrate or a Justice of the Peace, and
then return the documents to the Department.
