
Ottawa, October 27, 1912,

Sir,-

Referring to the proposed erection of the new school building at Indian Cove I have to ask you to confer with the Agent, Rev. J. D. McLeod, and report to the Department, giving information as to the style and size of the building you think would be suitable and whether any accommodation other than the class-room should be provided. You should also look into the matter of a site and report.

At this and the school at Bayfield it might be considered advisable to provide quarters for the teacher and the Department would like to have your views on the matter. Of course this accommodation will not be provided unless considered absolutely necessary. I shall be glad to hear from you in regard to the matter at an early date.
