

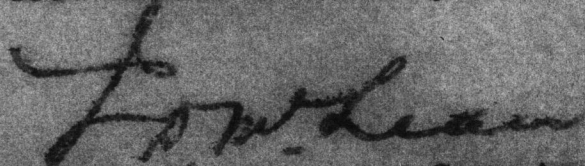

I beg to inform you that there has been sent you by registered mail File No. 410,256, containing correspondence relating to a strip of land situated at the Westerly side of the Cowichan Lake Indian Reserve. The strip is five chains in width and contains approximately 22.5 acres. I would draw special attention to the report of Mr. Inspector ^{of the 5th instant.} W. E. Ditchburn, and shall be obliged if the Royal Commission be good enough to advise whether, in its opinion, action should be taken to recover the tract of land in question.
