I beg to confirm the following telegram sent you yesterday:-
 Approval of purchasing posts, wire, four mowers, five plows, harrow
 carts and seeds. Get prices in same way as last year and purchase from
 lowest.

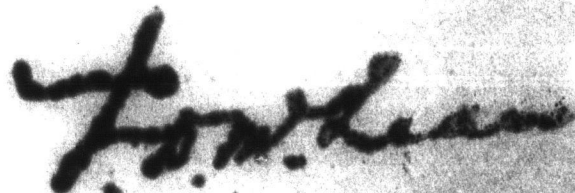
Tenders received by you should be forwarded with the accounts.

In addition to the above expenditure the amount required for road-
 work and ditching may be expended if necessary at the proper time. The ex-
 tension to the two farm stables may also be made at a cost of \$200.00
 each.

As to buildings, I am directed to say that nothing in this direct
 will be attempted this year.

The individuals who get the harrow carts should pay for them out
 of their crop funds. The cost should, therefore, be charged to them and
 refunds made to the land's account as these may be regarded as special
 farming implements.
