In reply to your letter of the 15th instant, No.733/11, I beg to inform you that in the opinion of the Department when Indians leave their reserves and are engaged with employers of labour as other persons in a municipality, the poll tax referred to by you can properly be retained by their employers as in the case of other individuals.
