Greves a drink of whisky which they had. Shortly afterwards witness, Pte. Greves, Lieut. Robb and Cpl Goldring all got into the car and with witness driving, drove to Epsom.

Fourth witness M-19541 Cpl. Goldring, C.S. Edmonton Regt., H.Q., Cdn Reinf Units, Mess steward, "C" Officers mess, H.Q., C.R.U. will state:

Between 1830 and 1900 hrs 1 March #2 witness went into the kitchen at "C" officers mess, H.Q., C.R.U. and saw Lieut. Robb talking to Ptes. Martin and Greves. Ptes Martin and Greves were discussing going out some place and it was suggested that Lieut. Robb go with them as he was unnerved over the death of his brother. Lieut. Robb went upstairs to get his coat and on his return asked witness to get a drink for Martin and Greves. Witness served Martin, Greves and Lieut. Robb with 2 single scotches each. At Lieut. Robb's suggestion witness took a portion of a bottle of whisky from the bar and witness with Lieut. Robb, Ptes Martin and Greves left in the car. Knowing that Lieut. Robb was very much upset witness accompanied him. Martin and Greves sat in the front seat and witness and Lieut. Robb in the rear. During the trip each of the occupants had one drink from the bottle of whisky.

Fifth Witness- Lieut. T.P. REED, w/s Officer, 1 Cdn. A.S.C. Reinf. Unit will state:

On 13 March 1942 witness examined left front tire and wheel rim of Ford Sedan, 1940, No. CM-195298, and I found them damaged beyond repair. The wheel rim had been driven with a flat tire, and is bent out of shape. The tire has the side walls pulled away from the fabric, and the cords are very probably torn and weakened. Witness does not consider the tire safe.

Sixth Witness- Capt. J.H. Banting, Assistant S. & T.O. H.Q., Cdn. Reinf. Units, will quote prices for wheel, rim, and tire casing, 6.50 X 16, as follows:
