TO DATE OF THIS LETTER

Sir,—

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 29th July ultimo with reference to a meeting of the Minister of Interior, the Deputy Superintendent General, yourself, and representatives of the "Allied Tribes of Indians" of British Columbia, to discuss certain matters affecting the Indians of B/ C.

Your letter also informs me that a representative of the Executive, of the "Allied Tribes," will, most likely call on me for information and, if so, you wish me "to give him whole-hearted co-operation by furnishing assistance and information in my possession as to what has already been done for the Indians in the way of reserves by the different Reserve Commissions."

In reply, permit me to state that I will, if called upon, carry out your instructions.
