- *Then shall the Bishop, or some Clergyman appointed by him, read one of the lessons following: Genesis 23, or St John 5. 21—30, or 1 Thessalonians 4. 13 to end.*
- *Then some Clergyman or other person appointed by the Bishop shall read the sentence of Consecration, according to the form on this page, which the Bishop shall sign and order to be recorded in the Registry of the Diocese.*
- *Then the Bishop shall say the Prayers before directed to be used in a Church-yard consecrated together with a Church, and also the Collect for All Saints' Day, as followeth.*

O ALMIGHTY God, who hast knit together thine elect in one communion and fellowship, in the mystical body of thy Son Christ our Lord: Grant us grace so to follow thy blessed Saints in all virtuous and godly living, that we may come to those unspeakable joys, which thou hast prepared for them that unfeignedly love thee: through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

- *After which a Hymn may be sung, and an Address given*
