A SHIN OF BEEF SOUP.—Have the shin cracked up well, put it to boil in five or six quarts of water: boil it five or six hours; skim it very often. Cut up very fine half a white cabbage, chop two turnips, three onions; put them into the soup, with pepper and salt, and boil it two hours; take the bone and gristle out before serving. If you have some raised dough, make up a dozen little balls the size of a nutmeg, and drop them into the soup, and boil it half-an-hour.
