For Primary Classes or the Home Lesson Fourth Quarter, 1917

I. OPENING HYMN. (Tune, Hymn 543, Book of Praise.)

In the name of God the Father, In the name of God the Son, And of God the Holy Spirit, Shall my worship be begun.

Father, Son and Holy Spirit,
Blessed God for evermore;
Standing in thy glorious presence
I will worship and adore.

II. PRAYER. While all remain standing let the teacher lead briefly in prayer.
III. A Welcome Song. (Tune, Hymn 585, Book of Praise, without repeat.)

VII. CRADLE ROLL HYMN. Two verses of the old Slumber Song to second tune, Hymn 197, Book of Praise.

Heavenly blessings without number, Gently falling on thy head. May'st thou live to know our Father, Trust and love him all thy days; Then go dwell forever near him, See his face, and sing his praise.
