TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING :

Know Ye that We have constituted and appointed, and by these Presents do constitute and appoint, the Honorables Lawrence O'Brien, and George Henry Emerson, Members of our Council of Our Island of Newfoundland, to be Commissioners, they or either of them, jointly or severally to administer the Oath of Allegiance to all and to every person and persons who is, are, or shall be a member or members of the General Assembly of our said Island, appointed by Proclamation of our Governor, to be holden at St. John's on the 15th day of this instant Month of January, giving to them, or either of them, our said Commissioners, full power and authority to perform the matters hereinbefore mentioned, ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever they, or either of them shall do and perform in this behalf. And thereof they or either of them, are to make due return under their Hands and Seals unto our Governor of our said Island with these presents annexed.

Witness our trusty and beloved CHARLES HENRY DARLING, Esquire, our Governor of our said Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies, at St. John's, in our said Island, this 14th day of January, in the Nineteenth Year of Our Reign.
