Four years ago they had, gone out, a gallant regiment of 1,400 strong, young men of the best families in Corunna. One of those frightful calamities which are more frequent in the Alps countries than here in Canada, occurred yesterday at the station of Glacier House, a beautiful spot, midway betweer Donald and Revelstoke, B. C., cn the Canadian Pacific Railway. A snow slide carried away the round house, killing seven men and maiming others. A fearful storm has cut off communication with the place.

Moscow, Jen. 31-The famine in Persia is growing more desperate, and the Shah, alarmed for his personal safety, has increased his bodygnard. In and around Tabriz, in the northwestern neck of Persia, between Turkey in-Asia and the Caspian Sea, the famine stricken inhabitants have taken to pillage and highway robbery. They have besieged the municipal authorities of Tabriz, clamoring for bread. According to to the latest advices received here. the police of Tabriz are powerless to put down the insurrection, and the Christians resident in Persia are careful of a general massacre.


