A Merchant Submarine

One of the most interesting happenings of last week was the arrival in Baltimore of the German submarine Droytschland, carrying a cargo of about 750 tons of dye-stuffs and other German exports. She expects to carry back nickel and crude rubber. The boat carries two small guns, but no torpedoes, and she can submerge in less than two minutes. It is reported she made the passage from Bremerhaven to Baltimore in fifteen days. She carries a crew of twenty-nine men. It is said that the boat traveled in all over 4,000 miles, 1,900 of this being under water. The fact that such a boat could run the British blockade and cross the Atlantic is a proof of German enterprise which her British seafaring foes will not be slow to acknowledge. But now that her presence in a United States port is known, her return trip may not be quite as successful as her outward passage, and the fact that one submarine got across the Atlantic in safety is not by any means a proof that a new and safe sea route has been discovered.
