Cottage industries, suitable for wo-man and children, will have the necessary attention at the rural agricul-tural school of each colony.

It is expected to draw 10 per cent, of the return in cash or kind of all allotments, which yield beyond a certain meausre, as an interest upon the stocks and seeds supplied free of cost by the Department of Agriculture.
