OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS

PERSON who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, who has a quarter section of small-land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must be a person at the Dominion Land Office or Sub-Agent for the District, by proxy may be made at any of our certain conditions, by father, son, brother or sister of the land homesteader.

Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may file a pre-emption or pre-emption six months before the expiration of the term of his homestead patent, and cultivate the land.

Homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption right for a purchased homestead in certain districts, price \$2.00 per acre. Must reside six months in three years, cultivate 50 acres and a house worth \$200.00.
