This is a FIXED WHITE LIGHT, burns at an elevation of 92 feet above high water, exhibited every night from sunset to sunrise, and in favourable weather will be seen from E. N. E seaward, to S. W. 12 miles. Vessels bound Northward by keeping this Light open with the North-head of Catalina untill Bonavista Light opens with Cape Le Jean, will give the Flowers Rocks an ample berth-or when coming from the Northward and bound for Catalina, by giving the N. Head a moderate berth, you will clear the Brandies
