### COURT REFUSED WORKER DAMAGES

Man Injured in Liquor Commission Warehouse Lost Compensation Suit.

Judgment holding that an employe of the Quebec Liquor Commission who was engaged in the handling and distribution of cases and boxe

Commission was not entitled to the benefits of the Workmen's Compensation Act has been handed down by Mr. Justice Gibson at Quebec.

The point arose in the case of Bedard vs. the Quebec Liquor Com mission where the plaint if sued to recover a sum of \$161.25. The plant tiff a leged that he was entitled to this sum as compensation . fo suffering and loss of time resulting from an accident which occurred or October 10, 1921 in a wa shouse o of the company where he was employed. He declared that one of his fellow workers allowed a box of liquor to fall on him causing an injury which necessitated hospital treatment for some time.

Mr. Justice Gibsone declared tha although the p'aintiff did not complain of the jnjury on the day tha ti occurred or on the day following this fact was not sufficient for the court to refuse to believe his statement to the effect that he was injured in the course of his work It been proved how ver said the judge that the plaintiff had been engaged simply to help in the work of handling boxes and cases in the warehouse. This work was done in a part of the warehousewhere no other motive force than that Of men or animals was used and accord ingly the plaintiffs work did not bring him within the scope of the


