

set of 1890, by which the Catholics were deprived of their schools, reached the city on Saturday last, and was delivered to the cause of the Catholics. Until we receive a full text of the judgment we can not form any opinion how their lordships arrived at a judgment which comes as a great surprise to all, and to none more than the government. To say that the judgment was a great disappointment as well as a surprise to us would be but faintly expressive of our feelings. We are not, however, going to initiate the Tribunes and insult their lordships as it did the judges of the supreme court of Canada, but will content our selves by saying that the judgment, being both by the authority and teachings of their Church, and the practices of their religious duties required to respect properly constituted authority, will not interfere in the reasonable utterances which the Greenway government and its local organs had the taste to do proper to the occasion, when they openly declared that they would not recognize the rights of the Catholics so master that the privy council might decide. Injustice and perjury at the hands of a hostile, fanatical and ungenerous majority is nothing new to Catholics, but disloyalty and sedition against authority are not their methods in meeting and overcoming such conduct on the part of their enemies. Whatever action we may take to preserve to our children the inalienable boon of a religious education, or at least to prevent the sacrifice, one thing may be relied upon and that is that our conduct and action will be of such a nature as to recommend it to all good men, and mayhap, make our enemies ashamed of their treatment of us.
