Mr. Hurdell says that it will not be an easy matter to reconcile a renewal of the Anglo-Japanese alliance with the movement for the consolidation of the English-speaking races, but he holds that the concordat is inevitable and may pave the way for an American-Japanese entente which will allay the nervousness and irritability in Australia and Canada.
