REPEATS OPERATIC SUCCESS AT GRAND

"Il Trovatore" Presented by Boston English Opera Company Proves Popularity.

SINGERS TRUE ARTISTS

Performers Exhibit Remarkable Genius in Rendition of Pieces.

By special request the Boston English Opera Company presented "Il Trovatore," one of the most beautiful and best-loved of operas, at the Grand Opera House Good Friday afternoon. London theatregoers were so delighted with the presentation by the company when it was here a few months ago that popular request forced the repetition.

The singers were not the greatest artists, but they were true artists who knew their score, and rendered it with understanding and poise, and at some points with a flash of genius. The beauty of the music lost something by dropping of the original Italian text. But, at the same time, the English text gave the singers this advantage—that they came into more intimate contact with their audience in the rendition of the opera.

The voices throughout the cast are delightful, admirably suited to dramatic work and lovely in quality. The chorus itself was adequate, the male voices being exceptionally fine. Outstanding among the ensemble numbers was, of course, the familiar "Ave! Chorus" sung de-

lightfully. Leonora's love song "Of Love Like This, How Vainly," was an exquisite number, and Azucena's wild air, "Upward the Flames Roll," sung with passion, was one of the numbers which will not be soon forgotten. Beautiful, too, was the duet of Manrico and Azucena, "Yes, Heavy Woes," sung in the dungeon, and Manrico's tragic air, "Ah, How Death Still Delayeth!"

The story of "Il Trovatore," which interpreted is "The Troubadour," is a tragedy which has its beginnings in the burning at the stake of an old Gypsy, who is believed to be practicing witchcraft. His daughter, the Gypsy of the opera, sets out to have vengeance. Her first act, an attempt at burning the child of the count who ordered her mother's tragic death, turns back upon her for she burns her own child instead.

The child who is left and who becomes the troubadour of the opera, is really the count's son, who later comes into conflict with his twin brother for the love of "Leonora." The result is a piling-up of tragedy, which is characteristic of grand opera, and which finds satisfaction only in the death of the lovers.

Saturday, matinee and evening, the company will present the "Bohemian Girl," which has already been acclaimed a success by Londoners who attended the two showings already given this week by the Boston English Opera Company.

NATIONALIST AGITATION IN TUNIS CAUSES ANXIETY

Bay Abdicates When Partisans Present Demands to French Authorities.

PARIS, April 14.—The nationalist agitation in Tunis on the eve of the visit of President Millerand, who is due there towards the end of the month, is attracting considerable attention, although up to the present it has developed any great force. The Communists have joined the Nationalists in the agitation, but it is said in official circles that the number of persons engaged in it does not exceed five or six hundred.

The abdication of the Bey has been reported and denied several times. It is now reaffirmed by a Frenchman, M. Fabre, who was expelled from Tunis, and who declares the partisans of the Bey presented 21 demands for reforms to the French authorities, the Bey abdicating when no satisfaction was given. To this report also an official denial has been given.

APPEALS ELECTION CASE

Counsel For Hon. R. B. Bennett Protests Court's Decision on West Calgary Contest.

CALGARY, April 13.—An appeal in the Bennett-Shaw West Calgary election case from the judgment handed down recently by Mr. Justice Stuart and Mr. Justice Ives, has been forwarded to the registrar of the supreme court of Canada at Ottawa by counsel for Hon. R. B. Bennett. The judgment of the supreme court of Alberta allowed Mr. Shaw the election by the majority of seventeen votes, the previous account giving him sixteen. The appeal forwarded on behalf of Mr. Bennett will be laid before the judge of the supreme court in chambers, who will decide whether the record has to be printed or not. He will then decide if the case is to be heard at the sitting in May or held over until October.

MONTREAL MAN STABBED

Stanley Smith in General Hospital With Two Knife Wounds.

MONTREAL, April 14.—What is thought to be an aftermath of the murder of Vincenzo Trescolli, who was killed in his restaurant in the east end of the city, January 5, last, occurred last night when Stanley Smith, 42 years of age, who was a witness in the Trescolli case, was stabbed on St. Catherine Street West, the city's most crowded thoroughfare, by a man so far uncaptured.

The victim received two knife wounds and is now in the general hospital, where his wounds are reported as not serious. At the time of the stabbing, Smith is reported to have said that it did not matter if he were killed, but that if it happened, some one else would be killed later.

SEIZE SHIP WITH WHISKEY

New York Police Patrol Raid Schooner W. F. Dodge Laden With Liquor.

NEW YORK, April 14.—The two-masted schooner W. F. Dodge, said to be bound from Nassau in the Bahamas for St. Pierre, Miquelon, with a load of liquor, was seized by a police patrol as she was entering the narrows late last night, it was learned today. The police said they found 25 barrels of rye whiskey and 403 cases of Scotch.

The craft, which was flying the British flag, was turned over to the customs service squad, and Captain Herman Hadley and his crew detained for an examination. The police said no clearance papers were found, and no documents were discovered to indicate her owners.

4 HURT WHEN OIL STILL EXPLODES

WHITING, Ind., April 14.—Four persons were injured, none seriously, and a fire, which for several hours threatened to prove dangerous, was started when an oil still of the Standard Oil Company exploded about 5 o'clock this morning. The fire was brought under control about three hours later.

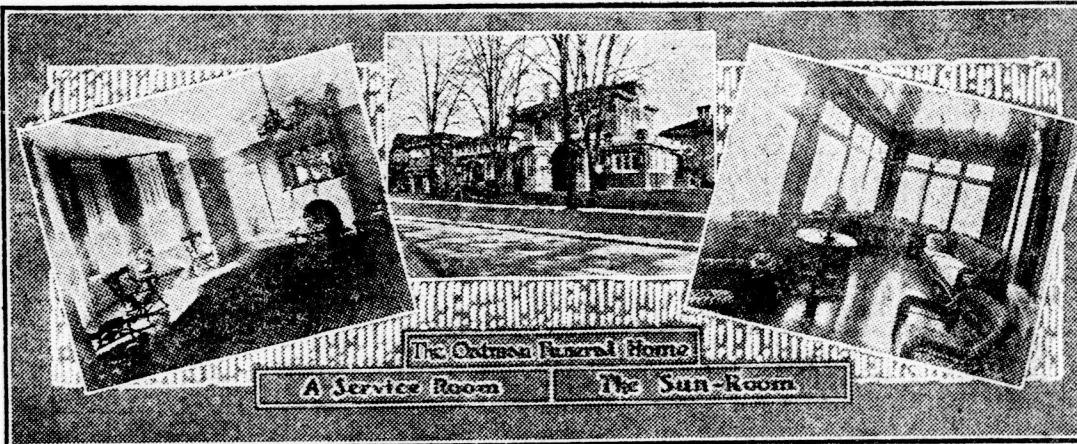

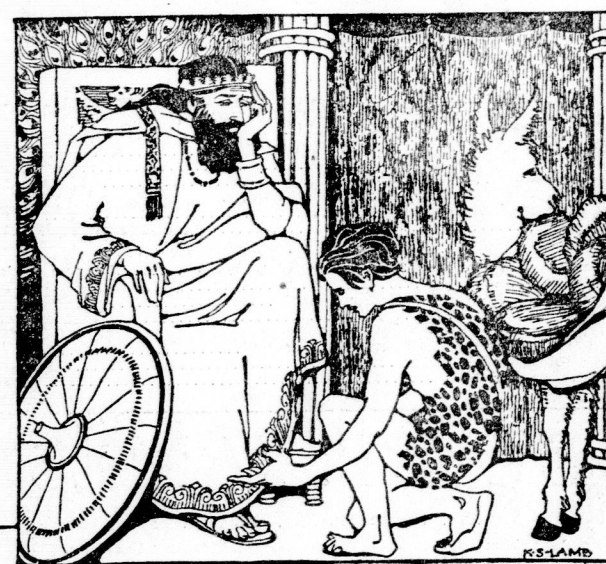
