SUMMON INCOME TAX DEFAULTERS

PORT ARTHUR, Aug. 3.—The prosecution of income tax defaulters is proceeding here, and upwards of 100 will be summoned within the next month.

The question of whether it is the intention of the Dominion government to send defaulters to jail on their inability to pay the \$50 is worrying court officials here.

Today a young farmer was convicted, but had no money to pay his fine, as he has been out of work. He was remanded, and an interpretation of the act will be obtained from Ottawa.

ALLOW CANADA TO TRADE WITH SOVIET RUSSIA

Diplomatic Overtures Result in Signing of Agreement in London.

RETAIN ALCOHOL EMBARGO

LONDON, Aug. 3.—Diplomatic correspondence which has passed between P. C. Larkin, Canadian high commissioner, the British foreign office and the Soviet government, Moscow, has resulted in the signing of a trade agreement between Russia and Britain, which will be immediately applicable to Canada.

This agreement involves not only trade relationship between the two countries, but gives facilities for restoring immediately postal, telegraph and wireless communications between Russia and Canada, thus assuring means of protection to Canadians traveling in Russia, and recognition of Canadian passports.

The agreement embodies Russia's pledge to cease from the dissemination of propaganda harmful to the British Empire, and gives each party the privilege of having resident agents in the respective countries. Canadians are now free to trade with Russia with certain minor restrictions, which is an embargo on the importation in Russia of alcohol.

A similar agreement has been in existence between Britain and Russia for over a year, but little business has been done hitherto because of the inability of the Russians to give what British traders regard as adequate security. Most of the trade so far has been done through the medium of jewels and valuables of different kinds which were forwarded from Russia to the Russian trade delegation in London, who in turn dispose of them and deposit the cash so obtained with the manufacturers whose goods they desire to purchase.

LOSES CLUB BAG.

Police received word Thursday afternoon that a Toronto woman had lost a black club bag on a Grand Trunk train between London and Listowel.

Her address is in an envelope in the pocket of a dress in the bag.

4 Sons of Farmer Lose Lives in Fire in Barn.

EDMONTON, Alta., Aug. 3.—Four sons of Luke Smith, a farmer of Glendhurst, sixteen miles northwest of Leduc, lost their lives in a fire which destroyed the barn in which they were sleeping, about midnight, Wednesday. The victims were: John, aged 15; Stanley, 14; Andrew, 10, and Peter, 8. A fifth son, Mike, aged 12, was the only one to escape. He tried to rouse his brothers, but they were stupefied by the smoke.

RESERVES ACTION AGAINST BUFFALO JITNEY DRIVERS

Judge to Follow Decision of Justice in Similar Case Tried in Albany.

BUFFALO, Aug. 3.—Decision in the International Railway Company's application for an order directing Mayor Schwab to show cause why he should not be compelled to force city licensed passenger-carrying automobiles off the streets was reserved today by Justice Pooley in supreme court.

The judge indicated, however, that he would follow the decision of Justice Hinman in a similar case tried in Albany during the street car strike there. This action against the operation of jitneys with the sanction of the public service commission was upheld by the appellate division.

FORGES NAME OF LIEUT.-GOVERNOR

Clever Swindler At Brantford Passes Several Bogus Checks Totalling \$925.

TORONTO, Ont., Aug. 3.—During the past week or so a clever forger, said to hail from Toronto, has passed several bogus checks on the Brantford branch of the Bank of Montreal. All the checks are signed with the name of His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor, Harry Cockshutt, and are indorsed with the name "L. M. Murphy." The known loss amounts to \$925.

The story is confirmed by Lieut.

Governor Cockshutt, who is at Brantford. As far as he could recall, five checks in all were passed through the bank, and they were in \$75 and \$175 denominations. The checks bore the imprints of the Imperial, Sterling, Royal and Dominion Banks in Toronto.

The forgeries are so good that they passed the expert scrutiny of the bank employees without difficulty. Private detectives are working on the case, and they hope to have the forger by the heels in a short time.

CHOP PARTITION TO ENTER HOUSE

TORONTO, Aug. 3.—To effect an entrance into the home of Hubert C. Cooper, 272 Roncesvalles avenue, thieves chopped their way through a walled partition leading from the cellarway up into the kitchen.

Mr. and Mrs. Cooper are holidaying at Honey Harbor, on the Georgian

Bay. Last night police officials found that the house had been ransacked, but were unable to ascertain if any valuables had been taken.

Sloan was the slab artist for the Classics, and while defeated, pitched a nice game. He had six strikeouts in seven innings.

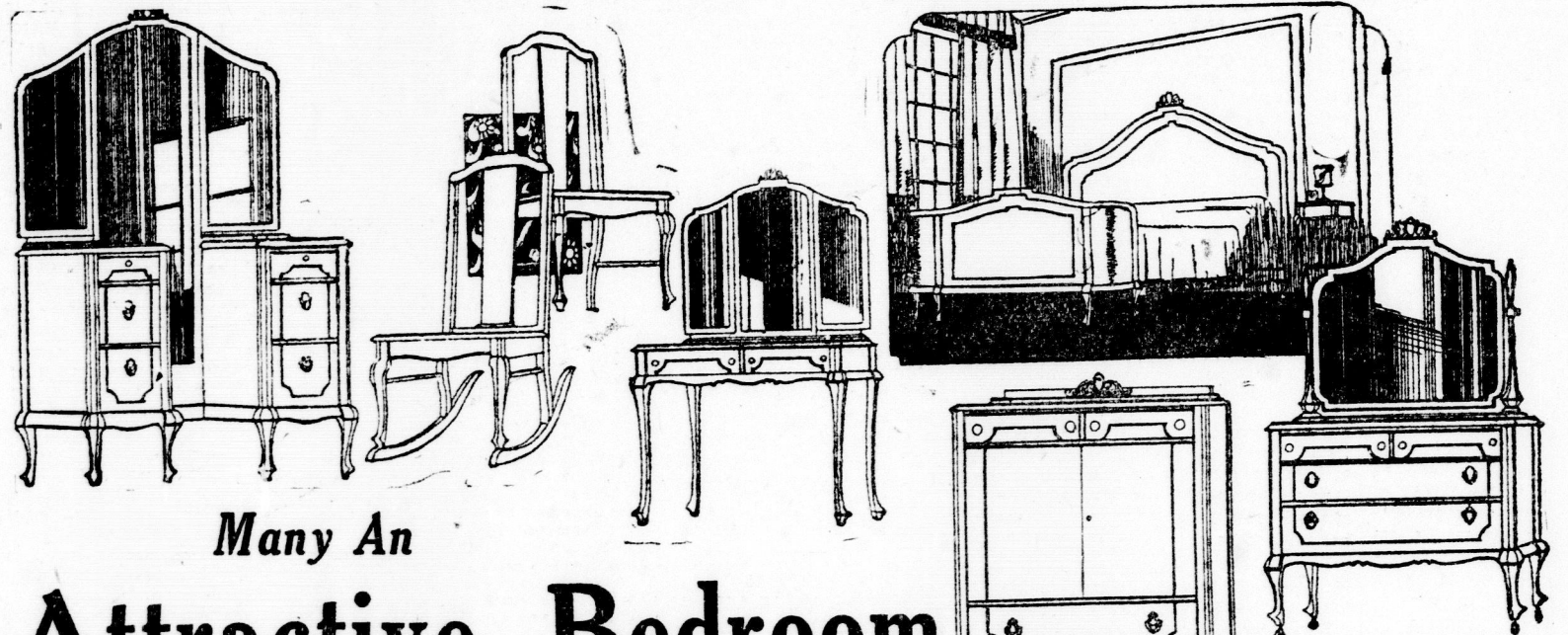
