The Situation Very Grave.  
In an interview this morning Dr. Jenkins

the situation becomes more grave."  
"Do you consider that it is getting  
beyond your control?"

"No, I do not," continued Dr. Jenkins.  
"While the situation is extremely serious,  
I believe we can still keep the disease under  
control and prevent it from reaching New  
York city."

Stamped Out in Great Britain.

LONDON, Sept. 9.—Official reports show  
that the cholera has been absolutely stamp-  
ed out of the United Kingdom. The Local  
Government Board officers, the authorities  
at the chief ports and the greatest  
population centres concur in the statement  
that no cases have been reported since  
but only a few cholera cases have occur-  
ed. Experts say that though the disease  
was brought to England by a steamer said  
points it has been limited to persons arriv-  
ing from infected places.

Still Injunctive in Paris.

PARIS, Sept. 9.—Sixty-three new cases  
of cholera and 40 deaths were reported  
this city yesterday. On the same day 22  
new cases and 13 deaths were reported in  
the suburbs.
