PREFACE.

THE CATECHISM OF SACRED HISTORY now presented o the Catholic public will be found, it is hoped, a seful little book for the lower classes in Catholic chools. There were, it is true, other Catechisms of . acred History in use in our schools, but none of them nswered exactly the purpose for which this was ntended, some being too large, and too elaborate for unior classes, whilst others had the answers entirely of long, so as to fatigue the memory of the young earner. The Catechism now offered has been enreally compiled from authentic sources, and has been hade as complete a compendium of Sacred History, nd in as simple a form, as could well be effected. It ill be seen that, in order to complete the history of he New Testament, a short account of the labors and eath of the several apostles has been added to the criptural narrative, so as to bring out more fully and fore clearly the connection between ancient Sacred listory, as contained in the Bible, and modern Sacred listory, which is that of the Church, commonly called cclesiastical History.
