The Trust have to report the following addition to the Fund, which consists of interest on Dominion Stock, and the small balances on deposit in the Bank of Montreal.

Harman, who recently sailed for England on business connected with civic affairs; on his return it is their intention to make arrangements for investing the balance in Bank.
