

METHODIST MISSIONS IN FIJI.

OW great a matter a little fire kindleth.
This saying is strikingly illustrated in the history of Methodist Missions in Fiji. On

the 8th of October, 1835, a small band of Wesleyan missionaries and their families, in the scheener *Blackbird*, reached the scene of their future labours, the island of Lakemba, in the Fiji group. As seen from the deck of the schooner, the island appeared to be surrounded by a continuous coral reef. The sea
