

February 10,
1958

The Integration of the former Fighting Units of the Pathet Lao military units of personnel, in accordance with the Military Agreement of November 12, was marked by a ceremony at Plaine des Jarres.

March 20

The Prime Minister informed the Commission of a Cabinet decision to request the withdrawal of the Commission as of the date of the supplementary general elections on May 4.

May 1

The Commission adopted a resolution concerning allegations of discrimination against Neo Lao Haksat.

May 4

Voting in the supplementary general elections took place.

May 8

The Commission in principle decided to withdraw all remaining teams subject to developments. Canadian Delegation tabled resolution on dissolution of Commission.

May 22

The Prime Minister informed the Commission that the Royal Government now considered the Geneva Agreement (including the obligations undertaken by his Government at Geneva Conference) to be fully implemented and referring to his letters of 26th of November 1957 and 20th of March 1958, he asked the Commission once again to withdraw.

May 23

The Polish Delegation while rejecting the Canadian resolution on dissolution proposed reduction in activity of Commission according to Article 39 of Geneva Agreement.

The Indian Delegation also rejected the Canadian resolution and put forward 2 alternative proposals.

May 31

The Prime Minister informed the Commission that the Royal Laotian Government intends to continue to observe the obligations contained in its declaration of Geneva in 1954.
