The Government of Canada and the Government of Australia ("the Contracting Parties");

CONSIDERING that the film industries of their two countries will benefit from closer mutual co-operation in the production of films; and

CONSIDERING that films capable of enhancing the prestige of the film industries and of the two countries should benefit from the provisions of this Agreement;

HAVE agreed as follows:-

ARTICLE 1

For the purposes of this Agreement:

- (1) (a) a "co-production film" shall be:
 - i) a film made by one or more Australian
 producers ("the Australian
 Co-producer") in conjunction with one
 or more Canadian producers ("the
 Canadian co-producer"); or
- ii) a film made by an Australian

 co-producer and a Canadian co-producer

 in conjunction with a producer of

 another country with which Australia

 or Canada has signed a co-production

 Treaty ("third co-producer");

and in either case the film shall be made in accordance with the terms of an approval as a Co-production Film given by the competent authorities jointly;
