An ICONDESK 4.3 Quick Tip

Would you like to find out whether or not a mission is on SIGNET? It's as easy as 1, 2, 3—just follow these steps:

- In Mail Manager, click on
 Message, then click on Send
 Mail;
- In the Send Mail window, click on Query. In the Address Query box, type in the ICONDESK code for the mission in the User Name box (e.g., -WSHDC); click on OK;
 - If the mission you queried does NOT have - CDCS as the suffix, then the mission is on SIGNET.

Please note:

- SIGNET clients-working in Annexes can be found in the directory service in ICONDESK by querying the mission code (e.g., you must now query "-Rome" rather than "-Romeannx"); and
- The ICONDESK code for the Halifax Summit Office is -OCONR.
