- c) to encourage exchange, on a reciprocal basis, of books, publications, periodicals and other material in the social sciences and humanities.

3. The sides confirmed that scientific and technical cooperation between the USSR and Canada on problems of the Arctic and North as organized on a regular long-term basis in accordance with the protocol signed in Moscow on April 16, 1984. The sides agreed at the meeting of the Soviet-Canadian cooperation group in Ottawa to review the fulfillment of the 1984-86 programme and to discuss proposals concerning the development of cooperation in 1987-90. The sides will study the question of concluding a special agreement on scientific and technical cooperation on problems of the Arctic and the North.

4. The sides will facilitate the signing and fulfillment of an agreement between the USSR Ministry of Public Health (Minzdrav) and the Ministry of Public Health
