

The Department of External Affairs announces
the following appointments:

Mr. Lawrence Joseph O'Toole, 42, now Director General
of Finance and Administration, to be Assistant Under-Secretary
of State for External Affairs (Administration) effective
September 1, 1972. He succeeds Mr. W.H. Barton who, as
announced earlier, will be the Canadian Ambassador and Permanent
Representative to the Office of the United Nations at Geneva,
and to the Conference of the Committee on Disarmament.

Mr. Georges-Henri Blouin, 51, now Director General
of Personnel, to hold the additional appointment of Special
Adviser to the Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs
on foreign service appointments and related policies, effective
September 1, 1972. He will also be the External Affairs
representative on the Personnel Management Committee of the
