2. Were any of these persons released because of inefficiency or misconduct and, if so, how many in each year, in each service, and for what reason?

3. How many persons with over 20 years' regular and wartime service have been honourably released from each of the armed services without entitlement to a pension since 1955?

Question No. 299, by Mr. Peters,—Order of the House for a Return showing: 1. How many railway crossings are there in Canada in each of the following categories (a) first-class highways (b) second-class highways, and (c) secondary roads?

2. How many in the Riding of Timiskaming?

3. How many of these are protected by (a) light and/or signal (b) underpasses (c) overpasses?

4. Is it a policy of the Department of Transport to authorize new highway construction without demanding an overpass or underpass?

Question No. 318, by Mr. Frenette,—Order of the House for a Return showing: 1. What works are being carried out at the present time by the federal government in the County of Portneuf?

2. What are the names of the contractors carrying out these works?

3. What sum of money has been granted for each such work?
