- (t) "standing committee" means a select committee appointed to consider and to report thereon to the Senate matters falling within the duties specifically assigned to it by these rules, and on other matters that may from time to time be referred to it by the Senate;
- (u) "substantive motion" means an independent motion neither incidental to nor relating to a proceeding or order of the day already before the Senate;
- (v) "two days' notice" means a notice where a sitting day intervenes between the day on which the notice is given and the day on which the motion or inquiry is made;
- (w) "writing", "written" or any term of like import includes words printed, typewritten, painted, engraved, lithographed, photographed, or represented or reproduced by any mode of representing or reproducing words in a visible form.

6. These rules shall come into force on a day to be fixed by order of the Senate.
