Dear Sir;-

We are in receipt of your letter of the 12th inst. and in reply we beg to take exception to the interpretation of the clause contained in Mrs. Eddy's Will in regard to her bequest made to the McGill University for the establishment of a Chair or Chairs, and to the publicity which you have given same in the different Pulp and Paper Magazines, as well as the daily press.

The idea of entering into any arrangement with either the Dominion Government or with the Canadian Pulp and Paper Association is certainly not in conformity with the terms of the bequest made by the late Mrs. Eddy in her Will, and, therefore, does not fit in with any proposed arrangement made by you with the Dominion Government and the Canadian Pulp & Paper Association for the joint operation and control of this fund by the Pulp and Paper Division of the Forest Products Laboratories, as stated by you.

Furthermore, we are not interested in any financial obligations which the Association propose to assume in this connection, and as far as this Company is concerned, they will certainly not be willing to assume any share of any additional financial assistance which may be required in making up any deficiency in any scheme or proposition to which they are not a party.
