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The Gospel. 8. Luke VIII. ver. 22 to 35.

NOW it came to pass on a certain day, that he went up in a ship with his disciples and he said unto them, Let us go over unto the other side of the lake. And they launched forth. But, as they sailed, he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake, and they were filled with water, and were in jeopardy. And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish. Then he arose, and rebuked the wind, and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm. And he said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid, wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this? For he commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey him.

In the Offertory shall this Sentence be read.

WHATSOEVER ye would that men should do unto you, even so do unto them: for this is the law and the prophets. *Matth. vii. 12.*

After the Prayer, For the whole State of Christ's Church, three others shall be used, viz. A prayer for the Reformed Churches, For our Enemies, and For Usury.

Then follows, Grant we beseech thee, &c. also, Almighty God, who hast promised to hear the petitions, &c. and the Blessing, The peace of God, &c. at the End of the Communion Service.
