

The Gospel. 8. Luke VIII. ver. 29 to 35.

NO W is come to pass on a certain day, that he went up into a ship with his disciples: and he said unto them, Let us go over to the other side of the lake: And they launched forth. But, as they sailed, he fell asleep: and there came down a form of wind on the lake; and they were filled with water, and were in jeopardy. And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish. Then he arose, and rebuked the wind, and the railing of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm. And he said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid, wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this? For he commandeth even the winds and waters, and they obey him.

Then shall follow the Nicene Creed, and after that the Lord's Supper, according to the **Symon.**

In the Offertory shall this sentence be read,

Whatsoever ye would that men should do unto you, do unto them also. **M**

After the Prayer, For the whole State of Christ's Church, three others shall be used, viz. A prayer for the Reformed Churches, For our Enemies, and For Unity.

Then follows, Grant we beseech thee, &c. also, Almighty God, who hast promised to hear the petitions, &c. and the blessing, The peace of God, &c. at the End of the Communion Service.
