

### CATTLE HIGHER IN MONTREAL MARKET

**Short Supply and Improved Quality Send Prices Up—Hogs at Advance Also.**

MONTREAL, March 31.—At the Montreal Stock Yard west and market the receipts for the week ended March 29 were 1200 cattle, 10 sheep and lambs, 2000 hogs and 100 calves. True supply on the market this morning consisted of 400 cattle, 100 sheep and lambs, 2000 hogs and 100 calves.

A much stronger feeling prevailed in the market for cattle, and prices since this day week show an advance of 25c to 50c per 100 pounds, which may be attributed almost entirely to the supply during the past ten days, and the improved quality of the stock coming forward.

From both butchers and packers, owing to the fact that most of them have now worked off their surplus supply, which they bought for the Easter trade. Trade was rather slow, as only actual wants were filled. The top price for the day was \$8 per 100 pounds, which was paid for five extra choice steers, averaging 1600 pounds each, and small lots of ordinary choice steers sold at \$7.75, and full loads of extra choice steers changed hands at \$7.25 to \$7.50, with choice butchers' cows at \$6.25 to \$6.50, and top quality bulls at \$6 to \$6.25 per 100 pounds.

A feature of the small-meat trade is the continued good demand for good choice calves, and as supplies of such are light, prices are well maintained at \$6 to \$6.50 per 100 pounds. Prices for the common stock is limited. Prices for spring lambs are lower, at \$5 to \$7 each, as size and quality of lambs and old sheep are scarce and firm.

A strong feeling continues to prevail in the market for hogs, and prices since this day week have scored a further advance of 25c to 50c per 100 pounds. Supplies are heavier than last week, but demand was good. Selected lots sold at \$10.75 per 100 pounds, weighed off cars.
