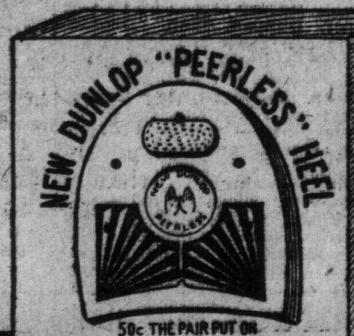

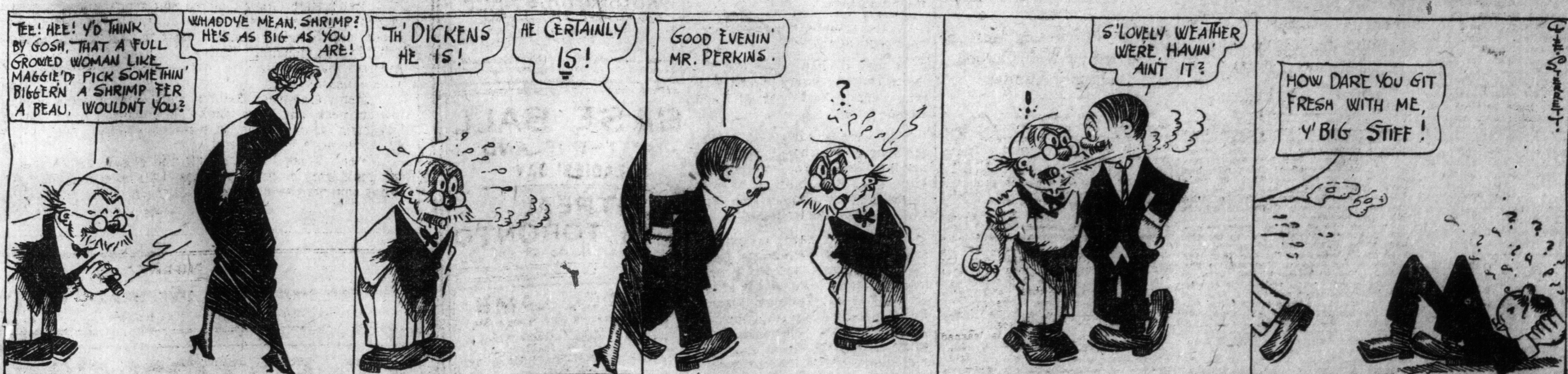

FAVORITES' DAY AT FORT ERIE

Six Public Choices in Front—Little Nephew Pulls Up Lane in Morning Work.

FORT ERIE, July 6.—Another large crowd attended the races today and keen disappointment was felt when the fifth race had to be cancelled. Little Nephew pulled up lame after his morning workout, and was withdrawn from the feature event. This left only Waterhouse and Night Hawk, and the stewards called the race off, substituting a six furlong dash. It was a good day for favorites, six showing in front.

Between the second and third races Waterhouse, jockey Smyth up, was worked over the Derby route, 1 1/4 miles, in 2:08 2-5 in preparation for the Derby on Wednesday. He was in hand the entire trip. Summary:
