Stock Touched the Lowest Point in Seven Years Yesterday.

NEW YORK, June 7.—Renewed speculation in Wall Street yesterday was the cause of a sharp decline in Canadian Pacific and other securities. The market was characterized by a general weakness, with the Dow Jones Industrial Average closing at 151.4, a new record low.

HEAVY TONE PREVAILED IN MONTREAL MARKET

Abrupt Decline in C. P. R. Effectively Checked Bullish Tendencies.

MONTREAL, June 7.—A four-point drop in the C.P.R. stock yesterday was the cause of a general decline in the Montreal market. The market was characterized by a heavy tone, with the C.P.R. stock closing at 104.00, down from 108.00 the previous day.

VISIBLE GOLD IS NOT A GUIDE

Hollinger is Not Paying Dividends From Clear Quartz.

STUDY IS NECESSARY

To Prevent Waste of Money in Developing Porcupine Properties.

In the report which he issued on the "Hollinger" in January, 1912, P. A. Robbins, the general manager, said: "In the quartz masses the occurrence of gold is extremely spotty and check samples taken from the same point on the vein will seldom agree within reasonable limits. Our sampling has shown that the occurrence of visible gold does not necessarily indicate payable values. On the contrary payable values are commonly found where no visible gold has been observed."
