

Constitution and By-Laws of the Canadian Medical Association Milk Commission

ARTICLE I.

Name—The name of this organization shall be the Canadian Medical Association Milk Commission.

ARTICLE II.

Purpose—The purpose of this Commission shall be to act as far as possible in conjunction with the various Boards of Health in inquiring into the milk supply of the various cities and towns throughout the Dominion and through the formation of local sub-committees to endeavor to secure such federal and local legislation as would warrant them or each municipality in establishing a system of rigid inspection, and the adoption and enforcement of such rules and regulations as may be found necessary.

ARTICLE III.

Membership—All members must be members of the Canadian Medical Association.

ARTICLE IV.

Additions to the membership of the Commission may be made by a two-thirds vote of the members present at any regular meeting.

ARTICLE V.

Local Sub-Commissions may be arranged for by the Commission under the authority of the C.M.A., whose Chairmen shall be ex-officio members of the Executive.

ARTICLE VI.

Sessions and Meetings—The Commission shall hold an annual session at the same time as the meeting of the Canadian Medical Association and in the same place.

Meetings shall be held monthly at the call of the Chairman.

ARTICLE VII.

Officers—The officers of the Commission shall be a Chairman, a Secretary and Treasurer.

The Chairman shall be appointed by the Canadian Medical Association with power to appoint a temporary substitute in the event of absence. The Secretary and Treasurer shall be
