copies of the matters respectively referred to them; and shall perform, generally, such other duties as may, from time to time, be imposed upon him by the Board of Delegates. He shall, within five days after the election of the Chief and Assistant Engineers, forward their certificates of election to His Excellency for approval. He shall, at the expiration of his term of office, promptly deliver up all books, papers and other property of the Department, and of the Board of Delegates, in his custody, to his successor in office.

ARTICLE XI.

TREASURER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

The Treasurer shall receive and safely keep all moneys belonging to the Fire Department, paying out the same upon the order of the Board of Delegates, duly signed by the President, and attested by the Secretary, which shall be his vouchers. He shall, at the stated meetings in February and August, submit to the Board of Delegates full reports of his receipts and disbursements, together with the amount of moneys remaining in the Treasury. His accounts and vouchers shall, at all times, be subject to the examination of Committees appointed by the Board for that pur-He shall, before entering upon the duties of pose. his office, give a bond, with one or more sureties, in the sum of one thousand dollars, (\$1,000) payable to the President of the Fire Department, conditioned for
