laft inftance the evident intention of rather admonthing you to return to your duty, than of \mathbf{F} lifting your difobedience, cannot fail to convince the world, that no political refertments (however well founded) are fuffered to interfere in the regulation of military affairs. It muft as forcibly thrike every man, unbiaffed by party prejudices, that, tho' the dignity of the Crown, and the welfare of the fervice required fome centure fhould be paffed on a conduct tending to the fubverfion of both, yet even this apparent feverity was tempered with benevolence and moderation.

I have now, Sir, performed my promife of examining the feveral fuppofed motives of your ftay in England, of ftating the probable inducements with Government, to order your return to America, of difcuffing the validity and import of that order, and canvaffing the pretences fet up against it. And now I fhould with pleafure take my leave of a difagreeable fubject, but that there appears fomething fo very uncommon in almost every part of your conduct, from the convention of Saratoga to the prefent hour, that curiofity tempts me to take a curfory view of it.

I will begin with your policy in framing the convention. And here the first object that attracts our notice, is your very fingular boalt, of having
