The chatteau is a large stone building, with a commodious spot as a court yard, or place of parade in front towards the town. Joined to this, is a large dining or banquetting hall: On the summit of an inaccessible precipice in front from this house and its gardens, we view the country east, and south across the river, and the whole of the lower town.

The most remarkable building in Quebec, is the Cathedral church, which is large, and attended by a numerous congregation. It is well adorned at the east end near the altar, but doth not make the same splendid appearance, with the parish church of Montreal.
