tokens of identity between us? why do we not call theirs ONE religion and ours ANOTHER? What points in common are there between the easy religion of this day and the religion of St. Athanasius or St. Chrysostom? How do the two agree, except that the name of Christianity is given to both of them?

"O may we be wiser than to be satisfied with an intrue profession and a mere shadow of the Gospel! . . . Pray that a divine influence may touch the hearts of men, . . . that so at length the language of the prophecy may be fulfilled to us: 'I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem,' 'The seed shall be prosperous, the vine shall give her fruit, and the ground shall give her increase, and the heavens shall give their dew,' and 'Many people and strong nations shall come to seek the Lord of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the Lord.'"
